18-0081609: Client is seeking assistance with filing for Chapter 7 Bankruptcy. Client has credit card debt from various creditors with a total of \$100,000 in credit card debt. He consolidated his credit cards in 2016 and was making payments of \$700.00/month, when he was involved in a car accident. He was not able to work and he stop making payments. Client has a mortgage with EMT Bank and is current with his payments. Client has a Fiat 2015 car payment of \$330.00/month. Client is current but can no longer make payments and is planning to turn in the car. Client has a 1993 pickup that is paid off. Client has not filed bankruptcy before.

18-0081799: Client recently had a heart attack and cannot find employment. Client owes \$20,000 in credit cards, \$4,000 in medical expenses, a balance of \$4,500 on a car with payments of \$175/month. He is a Co-signer on another vehicle, balance \$16,000 with payments of \$280/month. Client previously filed Chapter 7 Bankruptcy, discharged in 2009. His wife does not want to file bankruptcy.

She has credit card debt of \$ 63,000 and has not paid her cards in 3 months. Client lost her high paying job and was not able to keep up with her credit cards.
